Life for women is very tough in the rural communities of Pakistan. They have to play various roles at the same time. A woman is considered to be a perfect housewife and supporter of her husband on the fields as well. From the regular household chores to helping errands on the farms she has to be active and on her toes.

Allah Wasai is one such female who used to work on fields and do the entire household chores on her own. Being a mother and a wife she had to look after multiple roles for her family. She is a 30 year old female who lives in the community of Kamal Khan Lashari, district Khairpur. When OSDI set up the Hepatitis Prevention & Control Program in her village, she was diagnosed as a Hepatitis B+ve patient.



As a result she was unable to work for long in the fields and also do the daily household chores. Her health kept deteriorating and her family has to suffer the consequences. OSDI facilitated her with the medical treatment. Regular monitoring by the health staff and proper intake of medicines alongwith timely vaccinations has helped this lady to recover.

She now lives a healthy life with her husband and child. Not only this, but due to OSDI's intervention in providing her medical treatment she is able to regularly go in the fields and help her husband as much as she can so they may move towards sustainability.
