In district Matiari, lives Muhammad Ibrahim s/o Allah Jurio. He is the bread earner for a family of six. He is a dear father of 4 daughters and a son. Being a member of ADP, Ibrahim applauds the day he took this wise decision. He is about to become a graduate in this phase.

According to Ibrahim, “OSDI has been very much blessing for the villagers of Mari Muhammad Khan.” He recalls that before the intervention of OSDI, they had to cultivate their lands with the loan taken from

paddy vendors and Micro finance Bank, which used to charge them with high mark-up rates and provided them low quality seeds and other inputs. Due to which they barely came out of debt traps.

Since OSDI initiated its projects in the focused community of village Mari Muhammad Khan, the beneficiaries were provided with agro loans in the shape of inputs like tillage amount, seeds, fertilizers, pesticides and other related inputs. In this way they were able to get more production of their crop which led to more income generation and asset creation.

As his crop yield increase he was able to repay the loan taken from the micro finance bank. He then purchase one acre of land worth PKR 100,000/- and a motor cycle to commute. During the 8th phase of ADP he was also able to repay half of his agro loan to OSDI. Next he built an additional room for his family.

He and his family are thankful to OSDI for its support in improving their lives.
