

Case-Study:

Kando Mir Jatt: blooming prosperously

Kando Mir Jatt, a resident of Sukhio Mir Jatt, was under a burden of distress. For making both his ends meet, he used to drive a chinchi. Being a married man and having to support a family of five members, he was facing great hardships.

OSDI endeavored for his sustenance. He used to incur a huge cost on his chinchi, under the head of maintenance. The major portion of his income used to go invain and couldn't be saved. The leftover was insufficient to fulfill his needs. He used to run his chinchi from Sukhio Mir Jatt to Hala in pursuit of a better earning. Due to his adverse circumstances and lack of saving, the poor man had to sell off his vehicle.

OSDI under its LAP (Livelihood Assistance Program) helped him finance a loan of PKR 75,000. He pooled in the amount that he got after selling his vehicle which was PKR 30,000. Finally, he was able to acquire a new chichi rickshaw with the total sum, which enhanced his financial stature.

According to the field staff's report, after deducting all the cost that he incurred, Mr. Kando earned a profit of PKR 3140, during the two weeks, of the first month. OSDI'S representative also provided him with the training on book keeping, saving, and loan management which enabled him to keep a record of his monthly installments.

Mr. Kando's profit was reported to be PKR 37,320 up till the month of June, which is a dynamic one. OSDI hopes that he continues to thrive with the same zeal, in future.
