To aid these vulnerable youths to fulfill their dreams and promote entrepreneurship skills within them; OSDI under the Small Rural Enterprise Project (SREP), aims to provide microfinance interest free loans to the educated, talented and skilled youth living in the rural areas of our target communities in Pakistan.



In our continuous effort to strive towards improving lives OSDI facilitated a beneficiary, Sardraz Khan s/o Haider Khan from the targeted community of village Saheedabad, UC Rustam, district Mardan (KPK). Sardraz is an ambitious father of three sons and two daughters.

His son Sheraz Khan studies in the 5th grade, Ijaz Khan in grade 1, Faraz Khan in Nursery and both his daughters are under-age. However, he plans to educate them too.

Being a labourer in a block construction company he earned low wages. As a result financial instability made it very difficult for him to survive along with the upbringing expense of his family and children's education. Knowing about OSDI's SREP, Sardraz applied for micro-financing to initiate his own block making factory.

After reviewing and analyzing his business proposal the interest free loan was approved by OSDI. Today, Sardraz is earning more than PKR 30,000/- per month. Due to his hard work Sardraz is finally able to move towards sustainability.

Not only this, Sardraz has also hired two laborers as well to work in his factory at PKR 400 per day wages to each laborer. He is thankful to OSDI for bringing stability in his live and helping him increase his income to provide a better life to his children.
