

LDP Phase V – Ripples of Change

OSDI supports landless poor households living in the focused villages through its Livestock Development Project through interest free loan. Yousaf Dar s/o Amanat Khan is amongst the poor families residing in Badam who was considered during the fifth phase of this project.

He has five children's, one daughter and four sons. Previously, he was a laborer and earned little amount on daily wages which made it very difficult for him to make both the ends meet. Yousaf Dar was the bread earner for his family. He applied to participate in LDP – phase five as he had little experience of herding but because of financial issues he could not purchased animals. He wanted to earn some additional income. He wanted to purchase animals and sale them to generate some profit in order to improve his financial situation. Upon his selection to participate in LDP Phase five; OSDI purchased animals for him worth PKR 69000/- he took very good care of the animals whole-heartedly.

Yousaf sold these animals and earned PKR 37000/- as profit. He is very happy and requested OSDI to initiate the next phase of this project as soon as possible so he may purchase more animals and sale them to increase his income.

He repaid his interest free loan to OSDI and from his profit earned he constructed a room in his house. He also purchased one calf as an asset from the remaining amount.
