

Khan Sher – Earning Respectably

In the mountainous community of Prrang Dara in district Mardan (KPK) lives 45 years old, Mr. Khan Sher. He is the bread earner for 9 family members. His family comprises of 7 children and his other half.

Mr. Khan joined OSDI's Livelihood Assistance Program (LAP) for the Livestock Development Project (LDP) in the year 2020. Before becoming an LDP beneficiary Mr. Khan earned his living by working as a labour. His average monthly income was PKR 6000 – 7000. His only asset was a goat.



Upon joining this project OSDI facilitated him with 2 pregnant does out of which 1 kid was born at the time of livestock distribution. He now has 4 goats' in the form of assets and his family is able to enjoy excessive amount of milk produced from the goats which has helped them overcome food insecurity.

Due to OSDI's, facilitation Mr. Khan has enrolled his children in school. According to Mr. Khan, goats multiply more quickly due to herd increase as they breed twice a year. He believes that goats are raised in affordable rates.
