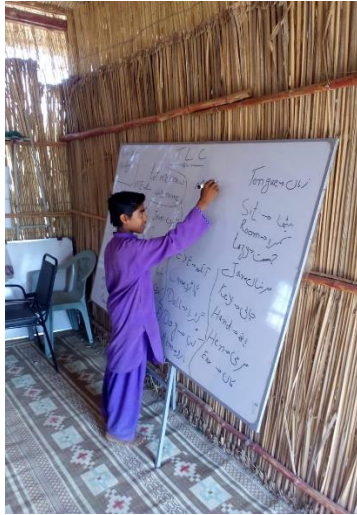


Motivated Student



Abdul Raheem, a resident of Moosa Goth had never thought his 11 year old son; Muhammad Bux could ever acquire education. To him education was not meant for the children of his village as it did not have any educational facility within the radius of 4 - 5 kms.

Because of the long routes and stray dogs roaming around people feared sending their children to school to another community. OSDI was requested by the villagers to intervene and construct an educational facility so they may have their children enrolled into our school.

Seeing the high illiteracy levels in this village, a two classroom based Temporary Learning Center (TLC) was constructed in the community of Chib Sheikh. OSDI formally appointed two well-learned male teachers who were committed to create positive ripples of change.

Muhammad Bux is amongst one of the fortunate student who immediately acquired admission in this TLC. He is currently studying in KG 2 grade. According to his Mr. Raheem, his son has started to enjoy his studies. He attends school regularly and does not waste time roaming around here and there.

Raheem thinks that with the provision of education there seems to be a meaning in the life of his child. Above all he thinks, his generation was lost because they did not have the access to education but for his child's generation they are fortunate to have OSDI working near their community.
