KEY UPDATES

OSDI has signed an MoU with ESEF to hand over its Community Learning Centers (Primary Schools) for sustained growth and impact.



AGRICULTURE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (ADP)

ADP Phase X - Cotton Crop

The cotton cycle concluded with farmers achieving an average of

24 maunds per acre

Before OSDI's intervention, they were able to harvest only 10 maunds per acre.

Increased yields translated into stronger household income and new opportunities for farmers to reinvest.



ADP Phase XI - Wheat Crop

Initiated in November, ADP XI supports 24 farmers through training on advanced agronomic practices, distribution of certified seeds and inputs, and ongoing monthly field visits by OSDI's agro expert to ensure better crop management and yields.

KITCHEN GARDENING Lasbela, Balochistan

Kitchen Gardening Phase V launched with 20 beneficiaries across 04 villages.

Each participant received support to grow their own vegetable plots, cultivating Asian Sweet Pumpkin, Turnip, Radish, Coriander, and Spinach.



LIVESTOCK DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (LDP)

LDP Phase VI - Mardan

LDP Phase VI, initiated in April 2025, has successfully reached its end term. The project focused on asset building for vulnerable households through the provision of productive goats, enabling families to gradually increase their herds, strengthen livelihoods, and build long-term financial resilience.
